



Provisional Operator's License

Ordinance 12.02 (g) (h)

(g) Operator's License (Am. Ord. #9-96:Am. Ord. #12-98)

\$15.00 per year or fraction thereof. Effective July 1, 1991, no new operator's license shall be granted unless the applicant has successfully completed a VTAE (vocational, technical, adult education) responsible beverage server training course or is otherwise exempt from such requirement under 125.17 (6) (a), Wis. Stats. The Clerk-Treasurer may issue a provisional operator's license to a person who is enrolled in said training course and shall revoke such license if the applicant fails to successfully complete the course. Operator's licenses shall be issued to any applicant qualified under 125.04 (5), Wis. Stats.

(h) Provisional Operator's License

\$15.00 for up to 30 days as provided in 125.17 (5), Wis. Stats.

1. – Provisional license fee: \$15.00.
Complete the application except signature. The form must be signed in front of and notarized by a Notary Public (banks are able to notarize documents).
Upon receipt of the notarized form and \$15.00 fee the Village office will be able to issue a Provisional license.
2. The Provisional license is good for 30 days. During this time you must complete a VTAE responsible beverage server training course (online). The Village office will require the certificate of completion to continue the process for your Operator's license.
3. – Operator's license fee: \$15.00.
– Certificate of completion beverage server training course.
A criminal background check will be done and your application will be sent to the Village board for approval. The board meets the first and third Mondays of each month. All fees, training and paperwork must be complete before an application is sent to the board for approval.
