Who is included?

Wisconsin Residents Who Have Been Issued a Driver License or State ID Card

A paper receipt will be issued at the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) office once all the required steps are completed.

- Request is processed within 2-3 business days and the card should be received within 10 days via USPS
- A receipt is issued for a driver license, and the receipt serves as a license to operate a motor vehicle while the license is being printed and mailed

The temporary license or card receipt is valid for 45 days.
